

Hospital Highlight: MedStar Southern Maryland

MedStar Health Southern Maryland Hospital Center (MSMHC) in Clinton, MD recently successfully completed their first TJC survey since the maternal standards for postpartum hemorrhage and hypertensive disorders of pregnancy were published. Completion of the maternal standards, while challenging during COVID, were cemented in practice ahead of schedule. As the only level 2 special care nursery in southern Maryland, high risk deliveries comprise 70% of MSMHC's 1200 births per year. There are 5 obstetric clinics that provide perinatal care to the patients who deliver within the 8 LDRs, 2 ORs, and 18 postpartum rooms. Families receive BabyFriendly, family-centered care throughout their stay.

Legislative Update

In May 2023, Prince George's county passed a resolution to create a standard for nurse and support staff patient ratios (<u>CR-013-2013</u>). The bill now stands before the PG County Council Board of Health where they are assessing the current staffing ratios in Prince George's County healthcare facilities.
