The focus of the event was Maryland's current perinatal and neonatal quality initiatives. Updates were given on collaborative data for both the perinatal and neonatal initiatives as well as data from the recently published 2022 Maryland Annual Maternal Mortality Report. All 32 Maryland birthing hospitals are working on an obstetric hemorrhage quality improvement initiative. The Jada team provided excellent education and presented the results of their Ruby study. On the neonatal side, the majority of hospitals are participating in a prevention and treatment of neonatal hypoglycemia initiative. Eastern Shore Chapter member and IBCLC, Karen Van Trieste, gave a fantastic presentation on nursing interventions to prevent and treat neonatal hypoglycemia. Karen made the education fun and interesting! All in all it was an amazingly successful night and we look forward to doing it again next year! LEGISLATIVE UPDATE SAFE STAFFING





In October we held a virtual letter writing campaign in support of Maryland Senate Bill 1020 Hospitals - Clinical Staffing Committees and Plans - Establishment (Safe Staffing Act of 2024). This bill, which has already passed in the House, will mandate hospitals to create staffing committees and adhere to the guidelines the committees recommend. Safe staffing is an issue that affects all healthcare workers and patients and MD AWHONN is proud to support this legislation. During our meetings, AWHONN members shared stories of difficult or unsafe situations that resulted from unsafe staffing. Some of the members were courageous enough to share their stories in writing, and those stories will be included in the final letter we will send to our state senators. Our next project will be to submit a request to Governor Moore to issue a special proclamation to create a maternal mortality month. - Bassey Etim-Edet, MS, RN, CNL, Legislative Coordinator




FALL 2024 NORTHEASTERN CHAPTER TRIVIA NIGHT




Eastern Shore Chapter Supports the Eastern Shore Pregnancy Center


